Solari Community Support Network Eligibility and Care Services

Description: Evaluates assessment packets for both adults and children received by healthcare providers or AHCCCS providers to determine whether an individual meets diagnostic and functional criteria to receive comprehensive, community based mental health care if eligible for Serious Mental Illness (SMI) services by following the states guidelines/criteria.

Eligibility: Adults who may have a Serious Mental Illness (SMI). Must have a behavioral health service provider apply for the evaluation.
